

Cookie Policy

Legal entity CoinKyt Limited Liability Company (hereinafter referred to as "we" or "CoinKyt") respects the privacy of Users (hereinafter referred to as "you" or "your") and strives to provide you with proper information regarding how you can manage your cookie files. This Cookie Policy is an integral part of CoinKyt Privacy Policy. It explains what are cookie files and similar technologies, what cookie types are set in your device when you visit the Website (as defined below), and how we use them. The Cookie Policy does not specify how we normally use your personal data.

In accordance with the legislation of the Russian Federation regarding the protection of personal data, we provide processing of subject's personal data, and the subject provides their consent in the form of a voluntary written (including in electronic form) or oral statement. This Cookie Policy, together with our Privacy Policy and User Agreement, regulates the collection, processing, and use of CoinKyt cookies, web beacons, tracking pixels, and other tracking technologies when visiting our Coinkyt.com website, as well as sub-domains of our site and other domains including the mobile version of the website or mobile application (the list is regularly updated), as well as pages associated with it or related to it (collectively referred to as the "Website"), to help customize the Website and improve User experience on our Website. All terms and definitions in this Cookie Policy are used in the same meanings as in the User Agreement, unless otherwise specified in this document.

1. What are cookie files

- 1.1. In alignment with common practices on almost all professional websites, this site uses cookie files or cookies that are tiny files set to your computer in order to improve the performance of webpages. This document explains what information they collect, how we use it and why we need to store it. We will also explain how you can avoid having this information collected or cookie files stored, but this may lead to downgraded performance or breakdown of certain website functionality elements.

2. How we use cookies

- 2.1. We use cookie files for different purposes listed below. Unfortunately, in most cases there are no standard industry-wide options to disable cookie files without completely disabling certain functions of our website and other websites. We suggest that you allow all cookie files to preserve the operability and integrity of the webpage features that you use.

3. Disabling cookies

3.1. You can turn off cookies by changing settings in the browser that you are using (check your browser manual for instructions). Note that disabling cookies will affect the functionality of this and other websites that you visit.

4. Cookies that we set

- 4.1. Cookie files related to your account. If you create an account on CoinKyt website, we will use cookies to manage the registration process and for general administration. These cookie files are usually deleted once you log out of the system, but in some cases, they can be preserved to remember your website login settings.
- 4.2. Cookie files related to system login. We use cookies when you log into our system so that we could remember your login parameters. This way you avoid having to log in every time you open a new webpage on our site.
- 4.3. Cookie files related to sending newsletters via email. This website offers newsletter or email subscription services, and cookies help us understand that you have already registered and show relevant notifications to subscribed and not subscribed visitors.
- 4.4. Connected cookie files. When you send your data using a form such as the ones with your contacts or comments, cookie files can be configured to remember your user data for later conversation.
- 4.5. Website customization cookies. In order to customize the webpages according to your preferences and ensure great experience, we save and analyze information regarding your navigation between pages through cookie files. We store cookies in order to show you relevant information whenever you interact with the website's pages.

5. Third-party cookies

- 5.1. In certain particular cases, we also use cookie files provided by trusted third parties and platforms. The following articles contain detailed information about third-party cookies that you may come across on this website.
- 5.2. This website uses trusted platform Google Analytics, one of the most common and reliable solutions for web analytics. This platform helps us understand how you use this site and how we can improve your experience. In this case, cookie files can track the amount of time you spend on the website and what pages you visit. Visit the official Google Analytics webpage to learn more about Google Analytics cookies.
- 5.3. Besides Google Analytics, we use third-party analysis tools to track and evaluate the time you spend using our Website. These cookies can track the amount of time you spend on this website or on pages that you visit.
- 5.4. We occasionally test new features and make small changes to our Website. While we are still testing new features, the already saved cookie files can be used regardless of changes to websites. This way we can add new functions that optimize and create new cookies.
- 5.5. Since we sell information products and services, it is important that we receive statistical data regarding how many visitors to our Website actually make purchases. Therefore, information regarding your purchases on the website will be tracked by cookies. It is important to you and to

the company because it helps us make accurate business forecasts depending on marketing and product costs. Such forecasts ensure that we offer you the best possible price.

- 5.6. We use advertising to offset the costs of this Website's maintenance and provide financing for further development. The behavioral advertising cookies used by this Website are designed to ensure that we show you the most relevant ads when possible by anonymously tracking your interests and showing similar products and services that may interest you.
- 5.7. Cookie files help us track and analyze the number of our clients who are redirected to us through ad traffic from our partners that place our ads on their websites. Based on clicks and transitions we can offer bonuses to affiliated accounts from our partners.
- 5.8. We also use social network buttons and/or plugins on our Website that allow you to connect to your social network in various ways. In order to make them clickable, social network websites set cookie files through our website. Such social network cookies are used and operate in accordance with their respective privacy policies.
